#### **ISSUE: YOUTH PROGRAMMING**

10/07/11 at 19:00...Life on the Rock Encore...60 minutes...Hosts Fr. Mark Mary and Doug Barry talked with Annie Bowman and Kathleen Eaton. Both ladies work with young women. They deal with issues facing young women like teen pregnancy. Also, they help women to cope with past mistakes in their lives. Doug said young men need to be there for young women and support them.
